
AIMVA QUALIFICATIONS SCHEME

The **Applicant** must have:

- a) A university degree from a recognised university corresponding to at least an AQF Level 7
 Qualification ^[1], majoring in geology, mining or petroleum engineering, metallurgy or a
 similar coherent discipline used in and by the minerals industry;
- b) A minimum of ten years of experience in her or his profession
- c) A minimum of one continuing education course in valuation and/or appraising of mineral assets as recognized by the Directors of AIMVA; or
- d) In lieu of the foregoing, satisfactory evidence of sound knowledge and proficiency in a field of valuation and/or appraisal of mineral assets.
